



#### **Greeter Ministry Request**




We are adding after Mass greeters and need your help. Have you ever eaten at a nice restaurant and the manager/owner met you at the door as you left? He thanked you for coming and invited

## **RCIA Rite of Acceptance and Rite of Welcome**

The **Rite of Acceptance** is the first public rite of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) for those who are unbaptized. During this rite, they publicly state their intent to continue their journey of faith to become Catholic Christians. The unbaptized are accepted as *Catechumens* (candidates for Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

The **Rite of Welcome** is for those who have been baptized in other Christian traditions.

They are welcomed as *Candidates* for Full Communion with the Catholic Church and encouraged as they continue their formation. **During the Rite**, sponsors will present inquirers to the assembly as people who are on a journey of faith, seriously considering becoming members of the Catholic Church. Sponsors and the parish community are asked to support these individuals as they go forward on this journey.

Beginning with this Rite, these individuals are encouraged to be with us each Sunday at the 9am Mass. After the homily, the Catechumens and Candidates are "dismissed" for Breaking Open the Word and prayerfully sent with members of our RCIA Team to reflect on the Scriptures. This time of reflection and discussion is an opportunity to continue to be nourished by the Word of God, until they are able to join us for the Eucharist.

**Pray for them!** These adults participated in the Rite of Acceptance and Rite of Welcome last Sunday at the 9 am Mass. Please pray for them as they begin the next step on their journey to becoming Catholic!
